













New Exhibitions at Sandwell Valley Country Park


Don't miss the first in our series of exhibitions in the Sandwell Valley Visitor Centre Tea Room!!



Multistory are thrilled to present **Nothing Gold Can Stay**, a group exhibition of newly commissioned work made during the second iteration of Assembly, an annual exhibition programme of newly commissioned work by emerging artists based in Sandwell and the Black Country. This year, the exhibition features the work of Mia Banks, Mandeep Dillon, and Tegen Kimbley. The artists' work explores the complex tensions between time, the production of images and the ethics of viewership, exploring how practices of slowness and deep attention ask us to view the world differently.
